## Display reading 1

Shows the current temperature from the latest measuring

Shows the average temperature during the previous 24 hours



# Display reading 4

Shows the average temperature during the current fortnight



#### Display reading 5

Shows the average temperature during the previous fortnight



#### Meter number

Each meter has its own unique number. This enables us to find information about temperature conditions in a given installation location, etc. at any time

FuturaComfort<sup>+</sup> is an important element in Brunata WebMon PTD – an Internet-based remote reading system for accurate measuring and presentation of the energy consumption in buildings.

However, Futura Comfort+ can also be used on its own, for it measures the temperature round the clock and also calculates average temperatures for selected periods of time.
